

ADULT LEARNER SCHOLARSHIP

Eligibility Requirements

- Age 24 or older at the time of college enrollment (fall 2019)
- Live in one of the six eligible counties (Wyandotte and Johnson in Kansas and Cass, Clay, Jackson and Platte in Missouri)
- Low- or modest-income
- Previously earned 12 or more college credits at an accredited, Title IV, postsecondary institution and has not earned a degree OR previously earned an associate degree and will use the scholarship to earn a bachelor's degree
- Not been enrolled in a postsecondary institution during the past academic year (fall 2018-spring 2019)
- Lawfully present in the United States or DACA eligible and DACA applied/approved

Scholarship Details

- Up to \$5,000/year paid directly to the college, renewable up to five years
- Previously earned 12 or more college credits at an accredited, Title IV, postsecondary institution and has not earned a degree OR previously earned an associate's degree and now wishes to earn a bachelor's degree
- Adult Learners can enroll in college either full time or part time

Traditional Scholarship

» Current 11th grader

- Home-schooled or attend a public, charter or private high school in one of the six eligible counties (Wyandotte and Johnson in Kansas and Cass, Clay, Jackson and Platte in Missouri)
- Low- or modest-income
- At least a 2.5 cumulative high school GPA OR at least a 16 on the ACT or at least an 800 on the SAT
- Lawfully present in the United States or DACA eligible and DACA applied/approved

Adult Learner Scholarship

» Age 24 or older at the time of college enrollment (fall 2019)

- Live in one of the six eligible counties (Wyandotte and Johnson in Kansas and Cass, Clay, Jackson and Platte in Missouri)
- Low- or modest-income
- Previously earned 12 or more college credits at an accredited, Title IV, postsecondary institution and has not earned a degree OR previously earned an associate degree and will use the scholarship to earn a bachelor's degree
- Not been enrolled in a postsecondary institution during the past academic year (fall 2018-spring 2019-summer 2019)
- Lawfully present in the United States or DACA eligible and DACA applied/approved

College Savings Account/Match

» Current 9th grader

- Home-schooled or attend a public, charter or private high school in one of the six eligible counties (Wyandotte and Johnson in Kansas and Cass, Clay, Jackson, and Platte in Missouri)
- Low- or modest-income
- At least a 2.5 GPA in 9th grade
- U.S. citizen or resident alien with a verified permanent U.S. address and valid Social Security number or other taxpayer identification number
